WHEREAS, volunteers are motivated by the simple satisfaction of helping their fellow citizens and making their community a better place to live; and


WHEREAS, these individuals have become a vital and positive force in our community and have demonstrated a shared conviction that the well-being of a community is largely dependent on helping others; and


WHEREAS, the City, to promote volunteerism, created a volunteer role to facilitate volunteer opportunities for those living and working in Mill Creek; and
