

Memorial Program

- Location will be selected in consultation with the Public Works Supervisor and will be on public property (i.e., parks, trails, right-of-way, etc.).
- Tree size and species must be approved by the Public Works Supervisor and must complement the existing and planned landscaping in the selected location.
- Text to be included on the plaque must be approved by the City.
- Installation will be by the Public Works crew or a subcontractor.
- The applicant will cover all direct costs including installation.
- The City will accept responsibility for maintenance following installation.
- Artwork to be donated must be approved by the Arts and Beautification Board.

The City shall have the right and discretion to repair, replace, move and/or remove any memorial that is damaged or injured.



Memorial Benches



Donating a tree or bench for a city park or trail is a wonderful way to honor a loved one and also provides a gift to the whole community.

You can participate in the Memorial Program to commemorate many occasions: in memory of someone who has passed away, in honor of a person or organization that has made a difference in the community, to celebrate a birthday, graduation, wedding, retirement, or other occasion. Items that can be donated are trees, benches, artwork, picnic tables, water fountains, and flag poles.

To participate in the Memorial Program, fill out the attached application card and drop it in the mail.

A certificate suitable for framing will be sent to the honoree or to the donor.

Planting a memorial tree is a remembrance of the past and at the same time a renewing of life and is a wonderful tribute to a loved one or friend. It's a gift that can last through several lifetimes; a gift that keeps on giving.
