## *Rotating Art Gallery in City Hall*

The Arts & Beautification Board of the City of Mill Creek is calling local resident artists to temporarily display their art inside Mill Creek City Hall.



To be considered please send up to 10 slides, snapshots, or digital images, the attached application and a self addressed return envelope to Rotating Art Gallery, c/o City of Mill Creek, 15728 Main Street, Mill Creek, WA 98012. Materials are reviewed quarterly.

*With this program the Arts & Beautification Board intends to increase public awareness, appreciation and understanding of visual arts through exhibits of quality work of emerging and professional local resident artists.*

Applications are now being accepted for the City of Mill Creek's Arts & Beautification Board rotating art program for display inside Mill Creek City Hall. The rotating art program seeks to present groups of visual works by local artists of all cultures, techniques, and styles. The Board will judge each exhibition and only reviewed and approved works will be exhibited. Exhibiting artists may be asked to attend a Board meeting to provide more complete information about their exhibition. The Board will base their decisions on artistic merit, quality of artwork, appropriateness and diversity. Proposals must include information on the artist, and recent images of the proposed works, along with any brochures or other printed material which may be appropriate. All works are to be framed and the content must be of a nature that a public entity can display for the enjoyment of a family-type audience. ### ***Policies:***

- Applicants must be Mill Creek Residents.
- All work must be original (copies of other works, class work and commercially prepared kits will not be accepted.) and created solely by the artist.
- Artwork must be framed in a professional manner i.e.; including proper backing, d-ring hangers (no saw-tooth or eye-hooks,) clean glass, clean cut archival mats, no debris under glass, wood frames only (metal frames may be considered case by case.) wrapped canvas (no visible corners.)
- Dimensions are to be no smaller than 13x16 and no larger than 50x50 finished size.
- All submitted artwork is subject to approval by the Arts & Beautification Board, who reserves the right to refuse any piece deemed unsuitable for viewing by a general audience of adults and children.

**NOTE:** The space is not an actual gallery setting. It is a public space with daily traffic and does not have adjustable lighting or much room to view large work at a distance. Artists should view the space prior to submission.
