## ***Council Meetings***

---

### **Regular Meeting**

Regular meetings of the City Council are held on the first, second and fourth Tuesdays of each month commencing at 6:00 p.m. in the Mill Creek Council Chambers located at 15728 Main Street, Mill Creek, Washington. Your participation and interest in these meetings are encouraged and very much appreciated.

Times listed on the agenda are approximate only. Discussions may sometimes cause remaining agenda items to be considered before or after their scheduled time or postponed to a future meeting. Citizens are welcome and encouraged to attend all sessions (except Executive Sessions) of the meeting.

The City Council may consider and act on any matter called to its attention at such meetings, whether or not specified on the agenda. Participation by members of the audience will be allowed as set forth on the meeting agenda or as determined by the City Council.

We are trying to make our public meetings accessible to all members of the public. If you require special accommodations, please call the City Clerk at 425-745-1891 three days (preferred) prior to the meeting.

### **Executive Session** **(Confidential)**

At the call of the Mayor, or with a majority vote, the City Council may recess to Executive Session privately to discuss and consider matters of confidential concern to the well being of the City. An announcement is made at the beginning of the session stating how long the session will last and whether action will be taken after the session concludes. The purposes for which an Executive Session may be held are identified through RCW 42.30.110. (Examples would be property acquisition, litigation, personnel matters, etc.)

### **Public Hearing**

Convening of public hearings are noticed in accordance with law and published in the local newspaper. Individuals wishing to speak during a public hearing should address the Council from the speaker podium after giving their name and address. Comments are limited to the specific matter for which the public hearing is held and will become part of the public record. Written comments and materials should be submitted to the City Clerk prior to the hearing.

### **Study Session**

Study sessions of the Council may be held as part of any regular or special meeting. Study sessions are informal, and are typically used by the City Council to receive reports and presentations, review and evaluate complex matters, and/or engage in preliminary analysis of City issues or City Council business.

### **Special Meeting**

Special meetings are open to the public and may be called at any time by the Mayor or by a majority of the members. Such public notice must be posted 24 hours before the time of such meeting as specified in the notice. Audience comments are limited to the topic only. The call and notice shall specify the time and place of the special meeting and the business to be transacted. Final action shall not be taken on any *other* matter at such meetings. No other items can be considered unless specified on the special meeting notice.

### **Audience Communication**

To comment on subjects listed on or not on the agenda, sign up on the sign-in sheet at the meeting or ask to be recognized during the Audience Communication portion of the meeting. Please stand at the podium and state your name and address for the official record. Time limitations shall be at the discretion of the City Council. There are two opportunities for public comment at the beginning and at the end of the meeting.
