

## DO I NEED A PERMIT?

(Residential)

No building, electrical, mechanical, or plumbing system shall be installed, erected, constructed, enlarged, altered, repaired, replaced, moved, improved, removed, converted, or demolished unless a permit has been obtained (2018 International Codes/2018 Uniform Plumbing Code).

## PERMITS REQUIRED

(Common Examples)

- Carports and garages.
- Decks more than 30" above grade including repairs.
- Exterior doors, windows and skylights that require a new opening.
- Fences including replacing an existing fence.
- Furnaces (replacement or conversion).
- Garage conversions.
- Gas piping.
- Interior remodels.
- Irrigation systems.
- Re-roof (except for in-kind reroofing, provided roof sheathing is not removed or replaced).
- Rockeries or retaining walls over 4 feet in height.
- Tree removal.
- Water heater replacement.
- Zero-clearance fireplaces.
- Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU's).

## PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

(Common Examples)

- One story detached accessory buildings not
- exceeding 200 sq. ft. used as storage sheds, playhouses or other similar uses. *Please note:* structures are still subject to property line setback requirements. Call City for more info.
- Retaining walls not over 4' from bottom of
- footing to top of wall not supporting a surcharge (a load imposing lateral pressure) or impounding hazardous materials.
- Painting, wallpapering, flooring, cabinets,
- countertops, and similar work.
- Playground equipment.
- Maintenance of existing landscaping or tree pruning.
- Bathroom and kitchen fixture replacements without plumbing line modifications, such as sinks and toilets.
- Appliance replacements without modification to gas, plumbing lines or electrical circuits such as dishwashers, ranges, ovens, washers and dryers, same location.
- Rooftop solar panels meeting exemption criteria.
